This Addendum is to clarify and modify the contents and scope of the aforementioned RFQ.

Section 2.2.3 Project Tracks (Page 7)

The last paragraph states the following:

“Respondents will be required to propose on both tracks, and Respondents are encouraged to include firms and / or individuals with strong conversion technology experience on their teams. The SWA reserves the right to short list or select a separate Respondent for each Track.”

This Addendum modifies the above paragraph as follows:

“Respondents will be required, at a minimum, to propose on Track 1. The SWA highly encourages respondents to propose on both tracks. Respondents are encouraged to include firms and/or individuals with strong conversion technology experience on their teams.

The SWA is not soliciting responses for only Track 2. Respondents submitting responses to only Track 2 of the GreenCycle project may not be considered for the next phase of the procurement process, the Request for Proposals (RFP). The SWA reserves the right to short list or select a separate Respondent for each Track.”

Section 7.0 COMMUNICATIONS PROTOCOL (Page 12)

The second paragraph from the bottom states the following:

“Recipients of the RFQ shall acknowledge receipt of all addenda by completing a form that will be provided if an addendum is issued. Failure to comply with this requirement may lead to disqualification from the RFQ process and future associated RFP processes.”

Since the RFQ has been distributed to a wider audience through various email distributions lists and internet postings, the SWA will not be enforcing the requirement that an addendum acknowledgment form be submitted.
